

IMATRA BIATHLON STADIUM USER'S GUIDE

1. These instructions are indefinitely valid.
2. Rules and regulations of the biathlon stadium are displayed on customer service point and web page of the city of Imatra. Every user of the shooting range is obligated to get acquainted with these rules and regulations.
3. Shooting on the range is allowed Mon – Fri 8.00 – 21.00 and Sat – Sun 9.00 – 21.00. Shooting is not allowed during official baseball games or other similar events.
4. Shooting on the range is allowed only with firearms that are aimed for sport shooting, such as smallbore-, air-, and non-lead rifles.
5. Inappropriate trespassing on the shooting range area is prohibited.

Reserving the shooting range

- Private persons' range reservations are done via online store, that can be found on the web page of the city of Imatra. Camp groups can do their enquiries & reservations by contacting matkailu@imatra.fi

- When booking the range, write down the estimated amount of firings into the reservation form, after your name.
- Reservations are charged in the online store, or in a separately agreed manner.

When arriving to the shooting range:

- Check that there is no one in the danger zone
- Check the condition of the shooting area
- Switch on the beacon that warns about shooting
- Perform your shooting by following proper discipline and order
- Take others' shooting into the consideration

Shooting must be interrupted immediately if:

- Inappropriate movement is detected in frontside of the shooting area
- There is a fire in frontside of the shooting area
- A human, animal or vehicle is detected in frontside of the shooting range
- Some other error is detected that can influence on the safety of shooting

When leaving the shooting range:

- Collect your equipment, used targets, empty cartridge boxes, shells as well as other trashes and place them into designated places
- Ensure that the shooting range is tidy and in immaculate condition after your usage. Thus, you will contribute everyone's comfort in the range
- Shut down the beacon and switch off the target controllers
- Report about equipment malfunctions or other detected problems concerning the shooting range to the stadium manager or Imatra real estate and area service's by placing a maintenance order
